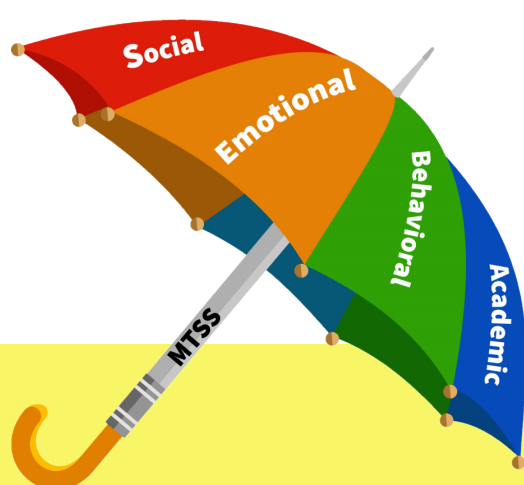
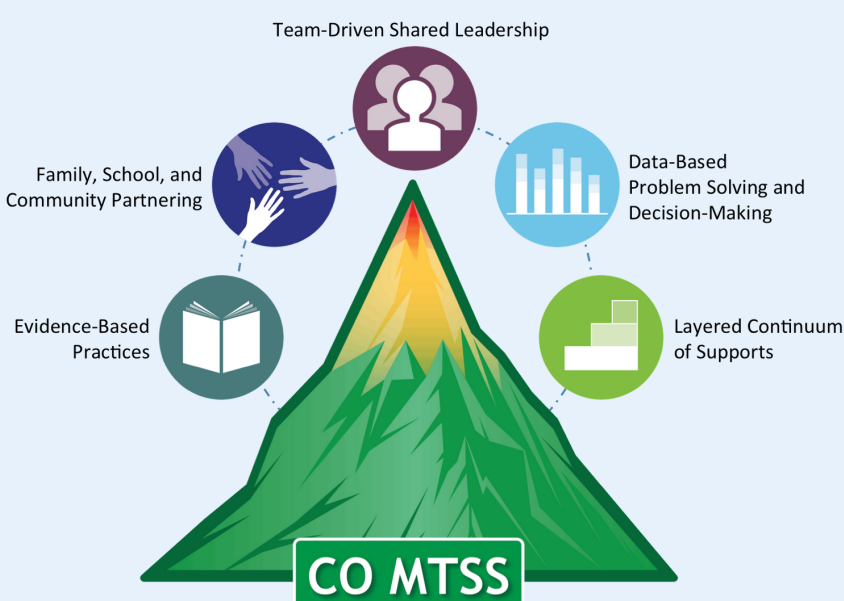

What is MTSS?

MTSS is a prevention-based framework of team-driven data-based problem solving for improving the outcomes of every student through family, school, and community partnering and a layered continuum of evidence-based practices applied at the classroom, school, district, region, and state level.

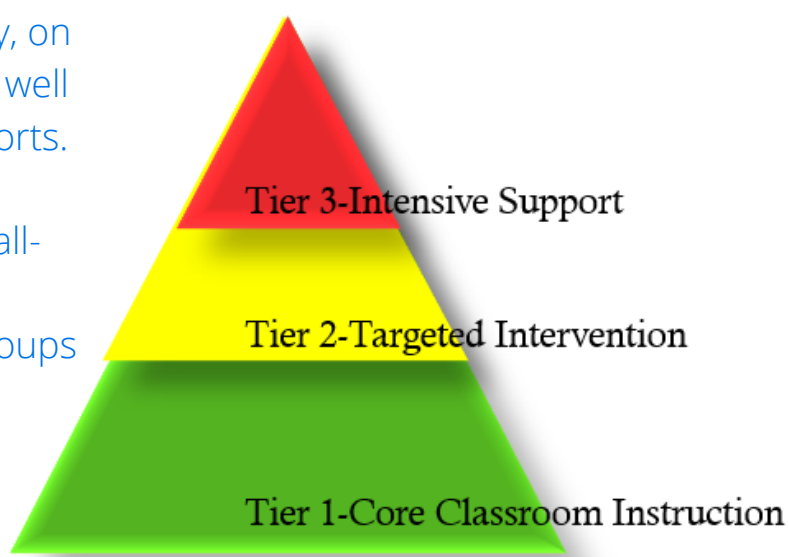


What are Tiers of Support?

Tier 1 – All students receive high-quality, on grade-level instruction in academics as well as social-emotional and behavior supports.

Tier 2 – In addition to Tier 1, students needing more support also receive small-group intervention and supports. The difference is increased time, smaller groups of students or narrowed focus of instruction.

Tier 3 – In addition to Tiers 1 and 2, students receiving Tier 3 intervention receive the most intensive supports based on individual need. The difference is individual team-based problem-solving, increased time, smaller groups of students and narrowed focus of instruction.



Types of MTSS Plans

Any time a student requires extra support to be successful in school, the MTSS Team and classroom teacher work together to create a plan to track interventions and data.

- Significant Reading Need-READ Plan
- Language Need-English Language Learner Plan
- Reading, Writing, or Math Need-MTSS Plan
- Social-Emotional/Behavior Need-MTSS Plan

If your child is placed on any of these plans, you will be informed by the classroom teacher. All plans require a parent signature.
