BEFORE SCHOOL (GRADES K-8TH)

Active play, cooking and healthy eating are core components of the program. Staff walk with all Stratton Meadows Elementary students to school each morning.

AFTER SCHOOL (GRADES K-5 TH)

A variety of recreational and educational options are available to all participants. Healthy snacks available through Care & Share Food Bank's Children's Nutrition Initiative. Children are escorted from the school to the community center each program day.

PAYMENT PLANS/ADJUSTED FEES
