# What Will You Find at Student Check-In

**Station 1 – Student Demographics:** Parents will verify their personal information (name, address, phone number, etc.) and if changes are needed, they will then sign into parent portal to fix and information that has to do with their name, address, email, phone number and contacts.

**Station 2 – Parent Portal Information / Activation:** Parent Portal will allow you to access accurate, current, and confidential information about your child's: School attendance, grades and class assignments. You will also be able to see District and school notices, email teachers, and receive newsletters. Please take the time to fix any info on your name, phone numbers, email or your address currently.

**Station 3 –Parking Permits/Fines:** Students who drive to school are required to have a parking permit. Parking permits are FREE and may be obtained throughout the school year. SHS staff will also be available to accept payment or make arrangements for any outstanding fine or obligation.

**Station 4 – Athletic Passes:** Athletic Passes are the best way to see you Stallion Athletes in action.

*Yearly Student Pass: \$8.00    Yearly Adult Pass: \$25.00    Season Adult Pass: \$15.00*  
Please make the check payable to SHS and on the memo line write "athletic pass."

**Station 5 – Pictures / ID:** All students will have their yearbook pictures taken during registration and receive their printed ID. IDs must be worn by all staff and students in the building as D2 increases building safety protocols.

**Station 6 – Information Center / Nutrition:** School information including bus and bell schedules. The mandatory Nutrition Service form which contains the Family Economic Data Survey must be filled out.

**Station 7 – Student Schedules:** Students can view their schedules on Infinite Campus. Schedule changes may be requested during check-in. There are no guarantees that requests will be granted. The last day a student must add or drop a class from their schedule will be August 26th, 2022.

**Station 8 – Laptop Checkout:** Guardians will sign paperwork and students can check out their laptop for the year.
