Use of Harrison School District 2 Transportation

The privilege of riding a school bus is contingent upon the student's good behavior in observance of the student code of conduct and established regulations for student conduct both at bus stops and on-board buses.

The driver of the school bus shall be responsible for safety of the students on the bus, both during the ride and while students are entering or leaving the vehicle. Therefore, it is the bus driver's duty to notify the supervisor of transportation if any student persists in violating the established rules of conduct.

After due warning has been given to the student and to the student's parents/guardians, the supervisor of the transportation or principal may withhold from the student the privilege of riding the school bus. The student may also be denied admission to school, suspended or expelled, in accordance with established policies, including discipline of habitually disruptive students, for flagrant violation of school bus rider conduct regulations or conduct detrimental to the safe operation of the bus.

Summer School Expectations

I understand and agree to the following expectations of summer school:

- The deadline to return registration forms to your child's High School is **May 14, 2019**.
- Payment: **See Above**
- Breakfast and lunch will be available for all students attending summer school.
- Enrollment in this summer program requires that student(s) attend for the full 12 days.
- **Attendance Policy: A student will be dropped from class, without refund or credit on the 4th tardy to class. A student will be dropped from class, without refund or credit, on the 2nd absence from class.**
- Summer school follows the same rules for student behavior that exist during the regular school year. Harrison School District Two's student conduct, discipline code, and dress code will be enforced.
- Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and will result in a referral to the office, loss of privileges, and possible removal from the summer school program.
- If students are withdrawn from summer school for disciplinary reasons, the student will not receive a grade for the course and will forfeit all fees paid. In addition, students withdrawn for attendance or disciplinary reasons will be prohibited from summer school grounds for the remainder of the session.
- My son/daughter will ride the bus home, walk, drive, or be picked up immediately after school, every day.
- Students driving personally owned transportation will be required to park in the designated student parking areas. Students are not permitted to loiter in the parking lot.
- All books or supplies must be returned to the school. If materials are damaged, students will be expected to pay for the damages.
