Lyft

Lyft has made 400 trips available to El Paso County residents through June 30. To secure a code, call 2-1-1. You will need a Lyft account to book the ride, and any minors will need to be accompanied by an adult. This service is made possible in a collaboration between El Paso County Public Health, Pikes Peak United Way and Homeward Pikes Peak.

Uber

Uber is offering free rides to all its users to go to and from vaccine appointments. Download the Uber app, create an account if you don't have one already, tap "Vaccine" and follow the prompts.

Envida

Envida, a Colorado Springs nonprofit, is offering free rides to and from vaccine appointments. Call (719) 600-2221 to reserve your ride.

Silver Key

Silver Key is offering rides for seniors to and from any vaccine appointments. Call the "Silver Line" main line at (719) 884-2300 or visit silverkey.org.

Find the nearest clinic

After you find a ride, you will get to pick where you want your vaccine.

There are more than 100 locations in El Paso County, including many pharmacies and grocery stores. Most locations are now offering walk-in services, but appointments are still accepted if you need to guarantee your time.
