

APPROVED, RESTRICTED AND PROHIBITED SCHOOL SPONSORED ACTIVITIES APPLICABLE TO ALL HARRISON SCHOOL DISTRICT TWO SCHOOLS

Approved Activities

The following activities have been approved by the District and do not require special waivers.

- Amusement Parks
- Archery at an archery facility (NOT on District property)
- Backpacking/Hiking (on designated trails only)
- Barbeques (away from any buildings on concrete or asphalt and with adequate supervision)
- Bonfires (must notify local fire authority and facilities services)
- Cross-country skiing (on designated trails only)
- Dodge ball (recreational ONLY)
- Ice Skating (at a rink)
- Mini-Trampolines (used by students in directly supervised activities as a part of the school curriculum. Not for cheerleading or school spirit activities).
- Skateboarding, rollerblading, roller skating(at skate parks or commercial facilities only – **NOT** on District property)
- Snow skiing or snowboarding (at a commercial resort within resort boundaries)
- Snowshoeing (on designated trails)
- Weight Lifting (appropriate supervision required; cannot have “open gym”)

The following list of RESTRICTED activities requires prior approval from Risk Management. In many cases, the activity must be coordinated through an outside vendor. Risk management and legal counsel will need to review any rental agreements prior to being signed and the vendor may be required to provide a certificate of insurance naming HSD2 as an additional insured. In addition, a “Release, Indemnity & Assumption of Risk” waiver form may be required prior to the activity. Please contact Risk Management at least two weeks in advance of the planned activity to coordinate these requirements.

- Aircraft landings on District property (including National Guard helicopters and tethered hot air balloons)
- Bike racing/activities
- Boating on commercial excursions on larger vessels of limited duration (examples: catamaran rides, harbor cruises and ferries)
- Club sports not sanctioned by CHSAA – Examples: ice hockey (boys & girls), inline hockey, rugby
- Fishing (NO ice fishing)
- Hayrides/tractor-trailer rides and parade floats
- Horseback riding
- Mechanical amusement parks, devices and rides, carnival rides
- Overnight camping/tenting (at designated camp grounds ONLY)

- Pyrotechnical events (fireworks)
- Rock Climbing (ONLY at commercial facility with appropriate number of staff certified to supervise and assist the students)
- Rope courses (must be established contractor with adequate insurance ONLY)
- Self-defense training (**NO CONTACT**)
- Water parks

The following is a list of **PROHIBITED** activities which shall not be sponsored by the District:

- Aircraft rides (other than large scale commercial transportation)
- Animal Exhibits/Acts (on District property)
- Boating in personally-owned watercraft
- Bungee Jumping/Bungee Runs
- Canoeing (river)
- Car Bashing
- Contact Martial Arts (such as Karate, Judo, Ju Jitsu, Tae Kwon Do)
- Crack the whip
- Circuses on District property
- Cruises overnight to any location
- Dodge ball (competitive)
- Donkey Basketball
- Dunk tanks
- 4-wheeling
- Hang Gliding
- Hot Air Balloons (**non-tethered**)
- Ice Skating (ponds or lakes)
- Kayaking (river)
- Motorized vehicles (operation of any motorized vehicle including motorcycles, motocross and minibikes)
- Ocean sports (surfing, scuba diving, snorkeling)
- Paintball
- Parasailing
- Rock climbing & Rappelling (outside/open air)
- Rafting and float trips (river or white water)
- Rodeo and roping events
- Skateboarding, rollerblading, roller skating (NOT on District property)
- Skydiving
- Sledding, tubing, and tobogganing
- Slip-n-slides
- Snow caving
- Trampolines (full-size)
- Velcro Walls
- Water skiing
- "Wrestling" games (mud or jello)
