



Wi-Fi Hotspot Checkout

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Harrison School District 2 has partnered with The T-Mobile Project 10 Million Program for an extremely important service opportunity to provide district students with Internet access for schoolwork at home. These hotspot devices will provide our scholars with opportunities to continue their learning beyond the school day. The program is specifically **for scholars without Internet Access at home**. Scholars check out a Franklin T9 Mobile Hotspot device for the **2022-2023** school year. These devices are filtered and Child Internet Protection Act (C.I.P.A) compliant in order to protect our scholars from accessing inappropriate sites.

This is a loaner device and scholars will have to turn this device back in at the end of each school year.

You will be given specific directions on how to connect the device to your child’s school issued laptop.

- not for getting around district network security
- not for social media or music or movies or for student’s phone
- for use at home only (except students taking college classes – and still may NOT have at SHS or HHS)
- 1 strike; you’re out – if found using hotspot at school, it will be confiscated and student will not be reissued hotspot for remainder of high school years
- **If you do not turn in your hotspot on the appointed day, you will pay a \$10 late fee AND may be fined for cost of hotspot charges or for use during non-authorized times (if not returned over summer) and also if hotspot is lost/stolen and not reported promptly**
